Musical Blockchain — World's first Creative approach to Blockchain+Al.

Where's the revolution?

We invented and developed a computer (AI) composer solution, who composes music, using provided user data (images/pics/text/binary) as a Source of Inspiration, building melody tone-by-tone using the Blockchain+AI with natural-like inspiration and improvisation processes.

This means that computer naturally looks at the provided data like a real composers would look at it — getting inspired, with all genius, brilliance and tension — while scoring the soundtrack.

We propose a new, innovative way for data-inspired psychology-based melodic sequence composition, sound generation, data-driven digital art and visuals generation, new fundamentals and methodologies for computer-based **Decentralized Improvisation**™.

This unique Al composer have no analogues in the world yet.

When it comes to Al/computer-generated works, computer-generated sequences powered by pre-trained models are proximate to the result of the work of a real human being.

The result usually uses previously predefined patterns to replicate styles, movements and techniques.

Our essential principle is to avoid randomly generated calculation results with pre-trained models.

We utilize machine learning algorithms for the data analysis and deep learning of the natural-like inspiration, using our in-house developed methodologies, psychological matrix with additional emotional markers to add human-like composer/performer behavior.

Natural-like improvisation and jamming processes done on a technological level with the aid of a *Blockchain*.

While currently all *Blockchain* applications for all Creative Industries is about rights management, storage/sharing, direct sales and money talks, **Musical Blockchain** truly connects art, music and creativity with technologies directly on many levels.

Why Blockchain?

Because we define musical composition as a chain of linked blocks.

Melodic sequence being built block-by-block by the network of *nodes*, working simultaneously, with an optional coordination by the *conductor*.

Nodes are building blocks in the same way as musicians in a studio creating a melody.

Each node in a network represents a different voice/instrument with own charisma/character, building its own part of a block.

Another block of melody being built when all nodes reach consensus.

Musical Blockchain already have a profound impact on the real world in a different ways:

We use our invention in the music, art, culture, education, urban/city development initiatives, number of social initiatives, medicine/psychology/audio therapy research, and various other areas.

We would like to offer a selection of highlights since our public launch in **July 2018**.

Learning Process:

3874 tracks have been generated for the learning/work processes during pre-beta and first public 6 months. Over half of it turned out to be unique music.

Music, **inspired** by user data and **not randomly generated**.

We again **boldly** pointing out, that we're <u>not using</u> models pre-trained on existing world's music/sounds for any sequence generation.

Learning done only using own generated music and classical music knowledge from last century.

"Kosmosonic Konglomerate with Musical Blockchain" artificialive multimedia act performs with own audio/video material and combines generative music, generative art, video projections, light and FX to create unique experience for a listeners/viewers, showcasing next level of a machine-human creative collaboration.

Act successfully performed at the **GMD Vilnius 2019** (Street Music Day) and **Kulturos Nakties Vilnius 2019** (Culture Night) — Vilnius' important culture dates — with a sets of new shows.

With the audience dancing and chilling during the performance — it was the best example that this AI-composed music is **The Music**.

Among the events, played in 2019 — Supynes Festival, No Trolls Allowed, EmEm Fest, Užupio Vasaros Kulturos Diena as well as other music/art/tech events in Lithuania and EU.

We already played **30+** successful artificialive multimedia shows and completed our "Pleasant, Unexpected!" mini-tour.

In 2018 we launched "Sound changes the City" series — interactive lectures, masterclasses and a city research project.

In 2019 we scaled our initiative and presented **Sound changes the City / Sound changes the Planet Global Initiative**.

What's new to hear?

Sound changes the City / Sound changes the Planet Global Initiative is revealing how ambient sound design can impact the urban environment and communities.

We propose **Sound** and its **Cultural impact** as a unique medium for a social and global change.

Bringing together Communities, Citizens and Artists, acting from the *City* and the *Sound* sides, together we're brainstorming, exploring and creating audial experiments and solutions that improving livability and walkability of the City.

Our focus — are results that could be used in a real life for the real City-related work and from the Artistic side.

Sound changes the City / Sound changes the Planet Global Initiative:

We're working with local and global companies, governmental organizations, communities and individuals.

Integral part — "Musical Blockchain for Cities+IoT" with the industrial-grade equipment

City Symphonies™ – highly anticipated unique musical shows (performed *live* with local musicians), composed from the City data of different districts using world's first true Al composer **Musical Blockchain**™.

City Symphonies™ are a permanently evolving <u>Audio Snapshot of a City's current state</u>. These musical shows are result of the *Human-Computer Interaction*.
